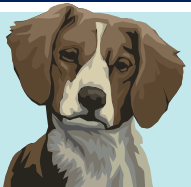

REQUIREMENT - Wisconsin State Statute 174.05 requires that the owner of a dog more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay the dog license tax and obtain a license.

LICENSE YEAR – The license year commences on January 1 and ends on the following December 31.

LATE FEES – The collecting official (Town of Verona Treasurer) shall assess and collect a **late fee of \$5.00** for every dog 5 months of age or over, if the owner failed to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or if the owner failed to obtain a license on or before the dog reached licensable age.



Hi, my name is **Buddy**.

A citizen from the Town of Verona asked me the other day..... What are the County dog license fee funds collected used for?

Well.....under county and state law, people who believe their animals were killed by stray dogs or stray animals may submit damage claims to their town board members, who verify the claims and forward the bills to the County Board. Money to pay the claims comes from the dog license fee fund. An individual can claim a maximum of \$1000 per claim regardless of species or number of animals damaged. However,.....**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Owner must submit claim to the Town Board within 3 Days of Occurrence.
