REQUIREMENT - Wisconsin State Statute 174.05 requires that the owner of a dog more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay the dog license tax and obtain a license.

LICENSE YEAR – The license year commences on January 1 and ends on the following December 31.

LATE FEES – The collecting official (Town of Verona Treasurer) shall assess and collect a late fee of \$5.00 for every dog 5 months of age or over, if the owner failed to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or if the owner failed to obtain a license on or before the dog reached licensable age.

LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF DOGS - The keeping of a large number of dogs poses health, safety and public welfare risks and is deemed a public nuisance. It shall be unlawful for any person to own harbor or keep more than four (4) dogs over the age of five (5) months, or more than one litter of puppies on any parcel containing two (2) contiguous acres or less.

2011 Multiple Dog Licenses application forms are available for a fee of \$55.00 (12 dogs or less.) Over 12 dogs \$15 or \$20 for each additional depending on sex. Please check with the Town office for a multiple dogs application form.
