

Snow Removal & Mailbox Tips

There is nothing more frustrating than clearing snow and then finding that your friendly snowplow operator has left a swath of wet, heavy snow across the end of your driveway. Believe it or not, our snow plow drivers try to shield to the left of you as you face the road. This will give the snow that accumulates on the snowplow blade a place to go before it gets to the end of your driveway.

Also, **check your mailboxes** and **posts**, it is your obligation to maintain your mailbox so that it is sturdy enough to withstand impact of snow thrown from the plow. Every year a few mailboxes are knocked into the ditch by the snow thrown from the plow. We make every effort to avoid this, but the plows need to maintain enough speed to throw accumulated snow well off the road. If our plows hit your mailbox or post, we will replace it with a standard \$12 black mail box from local vendors – the Town does not replace 'designer' mailboxes.
