


Are you aware that the Town of Verona purchased property in 2014 for the purpose of constructing a new Town Hall and Public Works facility?



Would you be opposed to or in favor of the Town setting aside an area that could be used for community gardens?




Would you be opposed to or in favor of the Town developing and maintaining a prairie restoration on part of the property?





Would you be opposed to or In favor of the Town developing and maintaining walking paths on part of this property?





Would you be opposed to or In favor of the Town developing and maintaining bike paths, horse trails, or snowmobile/ATV trails on this property?










