Horseshoe Bend Road Roadway Reconstruction:

The Town of Verona has completed planning and bidding the reconstruction of Horseshoe Bend. The existing pavement is deteriorated to the point of necessary construction. The project will reconstruct the roadway surface and areas of drainage adjacent to the roadway. Driveway culverts that are not working, rusting out, or collapsed will be replaced where necessary.

Access:

During construction, access along the roadway will be an inconvenience to the residents along the corridor. The roadway will be open during construction and will allow for emergency vehicles, buses, and garbage pickup as occurs currently. Residents will have access to their driveways at the end of the work days. Staff will work with the Contractor to notify property owners of work that could prohibit access for a brief period of time.

Schedule:

An exact schedule is not currently known but will be more defined at a preconstruction meeting set up with the Contractor in late May. The current contract, which includes other roadways in the Town of Verona as well, calls for the work to be completed by August 31, 2016. It is anticipated once the Contractor begins on this project they will continue until completion.

Property Limits:

The construction will be limited to areas within the right-of-way. In reviewing the project it was noted that some properties had flowers, plants and rocks near their driveway entrances. Landscaping within the Town right-of-way should be moved or understand that it may be damaged by construction. A majority of the work is directly within the roadway or immediately adjacent to the roadway unless a culvert is being replaced and then the limits move further up the driveway.
