Brush and Yard Waste – The Town does not collect nor accept brush or yard waste of any kind at this time. Options for disposal include burning (refer to Open Burning within this document) and contracting with a vendor for removal. Barnes, Inc. (608-845-3230) is a local vendor that offer this service.

Building Permits are required for new construction and home/property improvements involving construction, electrical work, plumbing, and HVAC. Permit applications may be found on the Town website. Click on “How Do I” on the home page to find the links to the application and related building permit documents.

Building Inspector – The town’s residential and commercial building inspector is John Crook. TEXT him at (608) 444-4894 (Monday-Friday 8am-4pm) for inspection requests.

Dane County Dog Licenses are issued by the Town of Verona. Residents owning dogs more than five months of age on January 1 of any year, or five months of age within the license year, are required to pay the dog license tax and obtain the license tag annually. Proof of rabies vaccination is required to obtain a license. The current year’s application may be found on the Town website by accessing the “How Do I” section on the home page.

Dane County Dog Parks – There are seven dog parks in Dane County including two within the Town of Verona. An annual Dane County dog park permit (or daily fee paid onsite) is required for all dogs using the parks. Dane County Landfill Effective September 22, 2023, there will no longer be direct access from US Hwy 12 & 18 and all traffic will use Exit 269 off US Hwy 12 & 18 to access the site from our newly constructed frontage road, Maahic Way/Landfill Dr. Due to this new frontage road, the following updated addresses will be effective September 11th, 2023:

- Dane County Landfill, 7102 Maahic Way, Madison, WI 53718

- Dane County Clean Sweep, 7004 Maahic Way, Madison, WI 53718

Clean Sweep will also now have a dedicated/separate entrance approximately 2,500 feet west of the current landfill entrance to alleviate traffic congestion on the current landfill driveway and improve safety for our staff, customers and visitors.

Driveway Permits are required for any addition, change, or improvement for access to private property. The application and instructions may be found on the town website. Click on “How Do I” on the home page to find a link to the driveway permit.

Fire Number Sign – The Dane County Code of Ordinances specifies that the owner of the land on which a numbering sign is located shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance of the number as specified by the ordinance. Placement information for the Fire Number sign is included in this packet.

Fireworks Permit is required for backyard and other displays in the Town. The fireworks permit application, along with a copy of the operator’s driver’s license, must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the event. Garbage and Recycling Collection – Pellitteri Waste Systems is the Town’s contractor for garbage and recycling pickup on Fridays. The carts should be at the street by 6:00 a.m. The Town of Verona provides trash and recycling carts at \$75.00 each. Residents desiring an additional garbage or recycle cart may contract directly with Pellitteri for the receptacle and additional pickup fee. For large items such as furniture, carpet, etc., contact Pellitteri at (608) 257-4285 to arrange for special pickup (pre-payment required). Open Burning – Town residents should obtain a burn permit from the DNR prior to any burning. Residents may burn the following: dry leaves, plant clippings, brush, and dry combustible rubbish that includes clean untreated/unpainted woods and *unrecyclable* paper and cardboard, if weather conditions do not pose a fire hazard. Please check the fire danger level prior to burning. In addition, please call the Verona Fire Department non-emergency number (608) 845-9401 to inform them of the date, place, and time of the burn. Plastic Bag and Films Recycling is available at Town Hall. In addition to plastic store bags, a wide variety of plastics are accepted. Please see the flyer in this packet for further details.
