

**RESOLUTION BY ELECTORS TO ENDORSE
TOWN of VERONA BOARD RESOLUTION 2019-08 TO EXCEED THE LEVY LIMIT**

Town of Verona, Dane County

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town tax levies for 2019 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes;

Whereas, s. 66.0602(5) of Wis. Statutes allows the town electors in towns under 3,000 in population to exceed the maximum allowable levy limit by adoption of a resolution at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, the Town of Verona Board has adopted a resolution supporting an increase in the Town tax levy which would exceed the maximum allowable state levy limit for the Town of Verona;

Whereas, a Special Town Meeting of the Town electors has been called and noticed to consider the adoption of a resolution to endorse Town Board Resolution 2019-08 to exceed the state levy limits, specifically by increasing the allowable town tax levy for 2019 (collected in 2020) by 2.5 percent;

THEREFORE, the Special Town Meeting of the Town of Verona, Dane County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 19th day of November, 2019, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

1. The Town electors of the Town of Verona, Dane County, Wisconsin endorse Town Board Resolution 2019-08 to increase the Town tax levy for 2019 (collected in 2020) by 2.5 percent over the allowable 2019 levy, which is a dollar increase of \$28,404 over the allowable 2019 Town tax levy.
2. The Town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under s. 60.80(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of adoption.

Within 14 days after adoption of the resolution, the town clerk shall certify the results of the vote to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue. See s. 66.0602(5) of Wis. Statutes.

Note that the town clerk must post or publish a Class 1 notice of this resolution within 30 days of adoption. See s. 60.80(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes.
