**Approval of Agenda-**

**Old Business-**

**Discuss Impact of Opting out of Dane County Zoning-**

Listed advantages:

Possible faster turnaround time

Better local control

Disadvantages:

Could possibly cost more to do if revenue not shared by County

May be open to lawsuits

May need more staff

Thoughts:

Dane County Towns Association- Zoning plan, how could we join cooperatively with other towns that opt out, share costs

Is Town really dissatisfied with County zoning enough to opt out?

Could we join City of Verona in zoning plan?

Continue for 3 years, then decide and wait until lawsuit and other towns show effectiveness of opting out.
