Roadway Reconstruction:

The Town of Verona has completed planning and bidding the 2017 roadway reconstructions. The Town of Verona will be reconstructing the Hillside Heights neighborhood with the exception of the areas along Alleghany that currently have curb and gutter. The existing pavement is deteriorated to the point of necessary construction and some drainage concerns are planning to be alleviated. The project will reconstruct the roadway surface and areas of drainage adjacent to the roadway. Driveway culverts that are not working, rusting out, or collapsed will be replaced where necessary. The image to the left shows the area impacted by the construction.

Access:

During construction, access along the roadway will be an inconvenience to the residents along the corridor. The roadway will be open during construction and will allow for emergency vehicles, buses, and garbage pickup as occurs currently. Residents will have access to their driveways at the end of the work days. Staff will work with the Contractor to notify property owners of work that could prohibit access for a brief period of time. Your patience will be appreciated. It will be worth it when it's over!

Schedule:

Based on a preconstruction meeting with the Contractor on May 25, 2017, the work is anticipated to start by the middle of July 2017 and be completed by September 1, 2017. A more specific start date will be known in a few weeks. It is anticipated once the Contractor begins on this project they will continue until completion. The Contractor plans to work from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 pm. Weather will play a part in how quickly progress moves and the exact dates.

Property Limits:

The construction will be limited to areas within the right-of-way. Landscaping within the Town right-of-way should be moved or understand that it may be damaged by construction. A majority of the work is directly within the roadway or immediately adjacent to the roadway unless a culvert is being replaced and then the limits move further up the driveway.
