The monthly Public Works Department Activity report is submitted for the information and review of the Board and the Committee. February was an active month with multiple seasonal winter snow and ice events, temporary pothole patching and equipment maintenance. Numerous citizen and resident concerns and action requests were received and addressed on a daily basis. If you should have any questions, please let me know.

Road Maintenance Activities

- 7 snow events and multiple freezing rain events.
- Performed various road pothole issues on Fitchrona Road and Whalen Road
- Replaced one culvert marker sign on Fitchrona Road

Equipment and Facility Activities

- Jones is waiting on final gas conversion equipment for installation and change over.
- Repaired the rear spreader unit on the Ford patrol truck
- Made miscellaneous plow and diesel effluent fluid system repairs

Sanitary Sewer Utility Activities

- Participated in a Public Information Meeting for the Badger Mill Pump Station 17 Force Main relief project with the Madison Metro Sewerage District (MMSD) staff
- Participating in data collection of the Badger Mill flow study.

Engineering Activities

- Continued working with the City of Fitchburg on the successful WISDOT grant application for Fitchrona Road reconstruction Nesbitt to Lacy. City of Fitchburg executed a State/Municipal Agreement for a total grant amount of \$2,886,086. Construction is likely 2025.
- Released the 2023 Road Maintenance project out for bid with a bid opening date of March 10, 2023 at 2:00 pm.

- Ordered and received the temporary canoe launch signage for the Valley Road bridge project. Construction to start in Spring 2023.
- Reviewed the current County Highway PD traffic study and widening plans.
- Participated is a conference call with USEPA regarding the Goose Lake/Fitchrona Road storm drainage project with the City of Fitchburg. The project has approximately \$150,000 of USEPA grant funding assigned to it. The City and Town staff will be requesting a cost proposal from the initial consulting engineering firm (AE2S) for final design engineering for the culvert replacement and associated permitting.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01

Town of Verona Dane County, Wisconsin

ORDINANCE TO REVISE COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

The Town Board of the Town of Verona, Dane County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1.05(5) of the Town of Verona Code of Ordinances shall be amended as provided below by adding the underlined language and deleting the language that is stricken :

(e) Committees. The following committees are established:

i. Financial Sustainability Finance Committee. Duties of the Financial Sustainability Finance Committee include advising the Town Board and Town staff on account balance goals and methods to increase revenue financial affairs.

ii. Natural and Recreational Areas Committee. Duties of the Natural and Recreational Areas Committee include advising the Plan Commission and the Town Board on open space preservation and improvement.

iii. [Reserved] Ordinance Committee. Duties of the Ordinance Committee include advising the Town Board and Town staff on creating and revising ordinances, policies, and applications.

iv. Public Works Committee. Duties of the Public Works Committee include advising the Town Board on road capital improvements, road maintenance, and capital equipment purchases, and reviewing road access.

This ordinance shall take effect upon publication or posting as required by law.

Resolution 2023-01 Town of Verona

A Resolution Addressing the Proposed Redirection of Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District Flow from Badger Mill Creek to Badfish Creek

WHEREAS, Town of Verona residents have for many years enjoyed diverse environmental and recreational uses along the Badger Mill Creek and the Sugar River; and

WHEREAS, upstream from the Town of Verona water is withdrawn for public uses by other communities, and for more than thirty (30) years has been returned to the Sugar River watershed after having been treated by the Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD); and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board understands that MMSD is seeking permission from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to no longer return treated water which originated in the Sugar River but to send it to Badfish Creek, in the Yahara River watershed, and,

WHEREAS, the amount of water returned to the Sugar River by the MMSD over the past decades contributes significant volume to the East Branch of the Sugar River; and

WHEREAS, diverting the water taken from the Sugar River watershed to Badfish Creek in the Yahara River watershed will permanently and significantly reduce the flow of the Sugar River in the Town of Verona, impacting recreational uses of the Sugar River, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town of Verona Board that the Town Board supports the reduction of Phosphorus pollution and the continuation of the current practice of the MMSD returning Sugar River waters to the Sugar River watershed.

ADOPTED by the Town of Verona Board on March 6, 2023, Dane County, Wisconsin.
